Description:

The Nurse Assistant will provide health care and first aid services to meet the needs of camp staff and campers. They will assist the camp nurse in the daily medication management, supervision and care of people admitted to the Health Lodge, and provide CPR and First Aid coverage as needed at designated times and location. The Nurse Assistant may also have to accompany campers off-site for clinic visits. A qualified candidate will have experience in children and adult illness/injury care, a desire to work with children, a service-minded attitude and have completed their first semester of clinicals in nursing school.

Duties include:

- 1. Under the direction of the Nurse, assist in providing health care and first aid services to meet the needs of camp staff and campers.
