



Keynote Speaker Announced!



Eliseo J. Pérez-Stable; M.D. is Director of the National Institute on Minority Health and Health Disparities (NIMHD) at the National Institutes of Health (NIH). Since joining NIMHD, Dr. Pérez-Stable has been cultivating the Institute's position on the cutting edge of the science of minority health and health disparities. Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, Dr. Pérez-Stable has positioned NIMHD at the forefront of the research response to COVID-19 health disparities.

Prior to becoming NIMHD Director, Dr. Pérez-Stable was a professor of medicine and chief of the Division of General Internal Medicine, at the University of California, San Francisco (UCSF). Dr. Pérez-Stable's research interests have centered on improving the health of racial and ethnic minorities through effective prevention interventions, understanding underlying causes of health disparities, and advancing patient-centered care for underserved populations. Recognized as a leader in Latino health care and disparities research, Dr. Pérez-Stable spent 32 years leading research on smoking cessation and tobacco control in Latino populations in the United States and Latin America.

We are pleased to announce that Dr. Pérez-Stable will be the keynote speaker for the 2022 ICAA held at UIC Student Center West in Chicago, Illinois from September 14th to 16th. Opening keynote TBD.
