

CMCT Travel Awards

The Center for Molecular Carcinogenesis and Toxicology (CMCT) provides travel support for graduate students and postdocs who are presenting original research in related areas. Awards (up to \$500) will be provided to eligible applicants each year. Upon submission, each application will be reviewed and a decision will be communicated within 2-3 weeks of submission.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be enrolled full-time and in good standing in graduate training at The University of Texas at Austin or assigned to a postdoctoral fellow position. Research papers or posters must already have been accepted for presentation by a recognized conference. Students/postdocs may **receive only one travel award per year.**

Application Materials:

1. A copy of the abstract of research to be presented.
2. Acceptance letter (if appropriate) for the research presentation.
3. Completed application form.
4. Amount requested.
