Background

The UT International Office (IO) is seeking a graduate assistant to support its Summer 2015 immersion programs for visiting university students from China. These programs aim to provide participants with a vibrant academic and cultural experience.

U.S. Academic Culture & Immersion Program (ACIP)

ACIP was designed for the <u>Severn Institute</u> and will be administered by International Student & Scholar Services in collaboration with ESL Services, the <u>UT Global Initiative for Education & Leadership</u> and the <u>UT Leadership & Ethics Institute</u>. Participants will engage in a dynamic and holistic program designed around four components: targeted academic content, leadership workshops, community service, and civic & cultural activities.

U.S. Sports & Culture Immersion Program (SCIP)

Created for the Shanghai University of Sport, SCIP is a partnership between International Student & Scholar Services and the College of Education's Physical Education Teacher Education Program. Participants will learn about physical education & sports training in the U.S., engage in panel discussions, and attend workshops administered by UT athletic units. Participants will also visit various sporting events & venues and partake in cultural excursions to better understand U.S. history & culture.

Responsibilities

The Graduate Assistant (GA) will report directly to the ACIP/SCIP Program Coordinator, providing administrative and program management support as needed. Key responsibilities of the GA will include:

- Coordinating logistics including room reservations, transportation, and catering
- Transporting and accompanying program participants to various site visits and special events
- Moderating and contributing to social media pages (Facebook /Twitter/Instagram/etc.)
- Administrative tasks related to the program
- Other duties as necessary

This position is short-term and time-intensive. Please consider other academic responsibilities and employment commitments when applying.

- Must be classified as a Graduate Student at UT Austin
- Excellent interpersonal communication skills
- Excellent organizational skills
- Work well independently and with teams
- Demonstrated leadership experience in a cross cultural context
