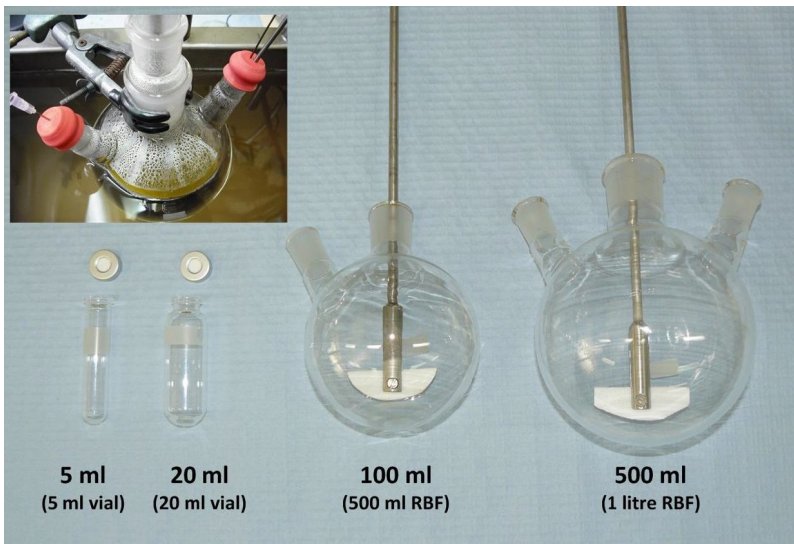


Lavatory Safety Update
