

2024 Call for Papers

The Guest Editorial Board is seeking papers for the Special Issue of the *Hispanic Journal of Behavioral Sciences* (HJBS) entitled *Latinos Living with Dementia*. Original empirical papers that examine severe cognitive impairment and its association with social, cultural, demographic, and economic factors or health policy will be considered. We welcome studies from anthropology, economics, education, linguistics, political science, psychology, psychiatry, public health, public policy, and sociology.

HJBS Papers must follow APA bibliographic style [apa_style_november_2019.pdf \(sagepub.com\)](#) and between 4000-8000 words. The completed manuscript submission is due **October 15, 2024**.

Feedback will be sent to the authors of each paper and, if the review is positive, authors will be given 14 days to respond. Each author will provide a written response to the critique with their revised manuscript. The final version of the manuscript submission is **November 15, 2024**.

Articles will appear in the first published issue of HJBS in **February 2025**.
