# HOW IS A RESUME DIFFERENT THAN A CV?

A resume is a summary of your experiences. A CV (curriculum vitae) is a full history of your academic achievements and credentials.

A CV is mainly used by graduate students, academic professionals, and late-career artists & performers.

A resume is a document that summarizes your professional experiences and qualifications.

# **OVERVIEW:**

An early-career resume (like when you're a student) should be **one page** 

For a general resume, you should have these **four sections:** contact information, education, experience, and technical skills

> **Never** include your hobbies (unless they play a role in your professional experience) or an objective section

Boring is better! The majority of resumes are read by ATS (Applicant Tracking Systems) softwares.
Graphics and intricate layouts often trip these softwares up, which can take you out of the running

Make your header stand out, but don't go too overboard
