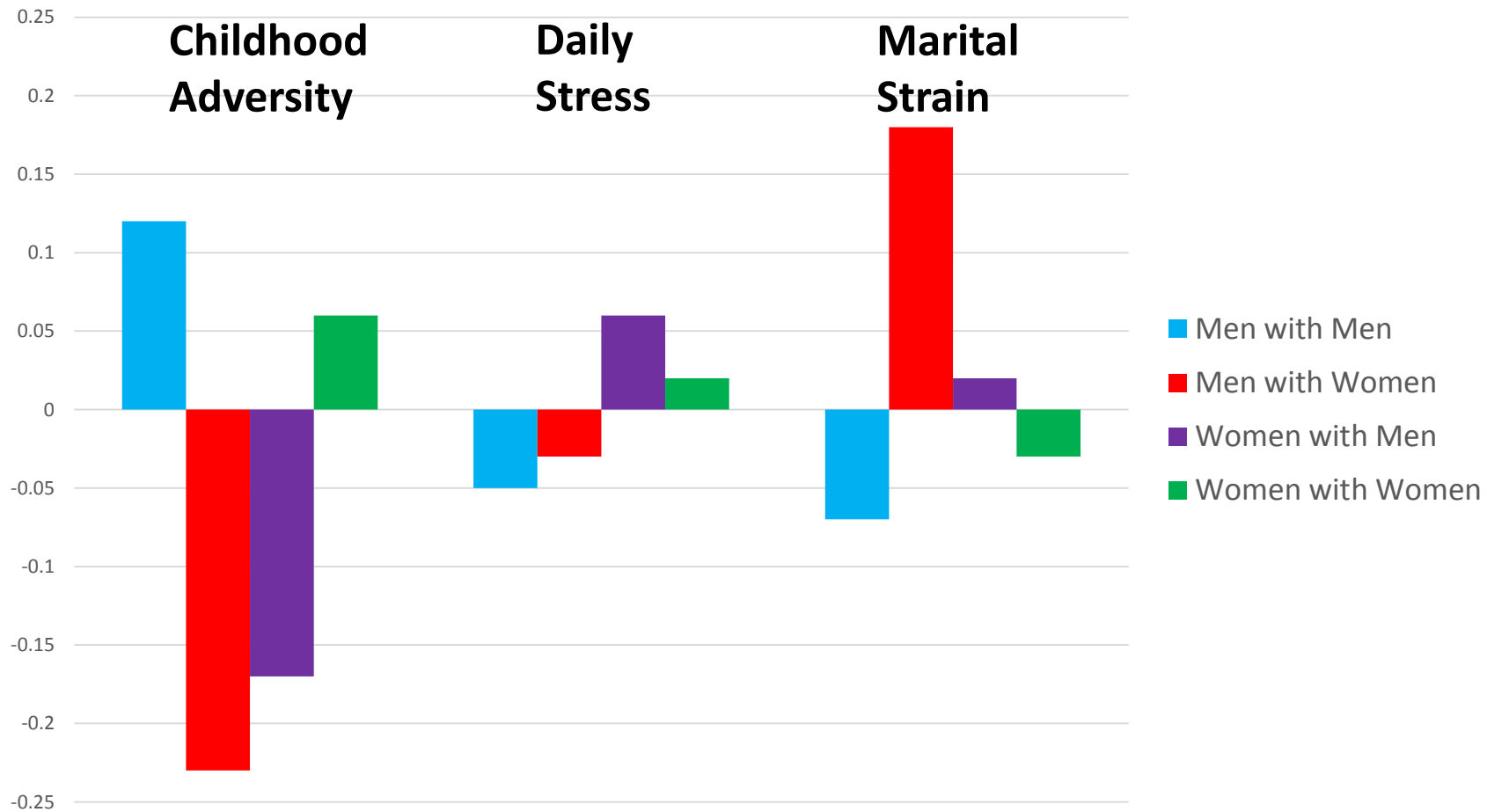


Why Include Same-Sex Couples?

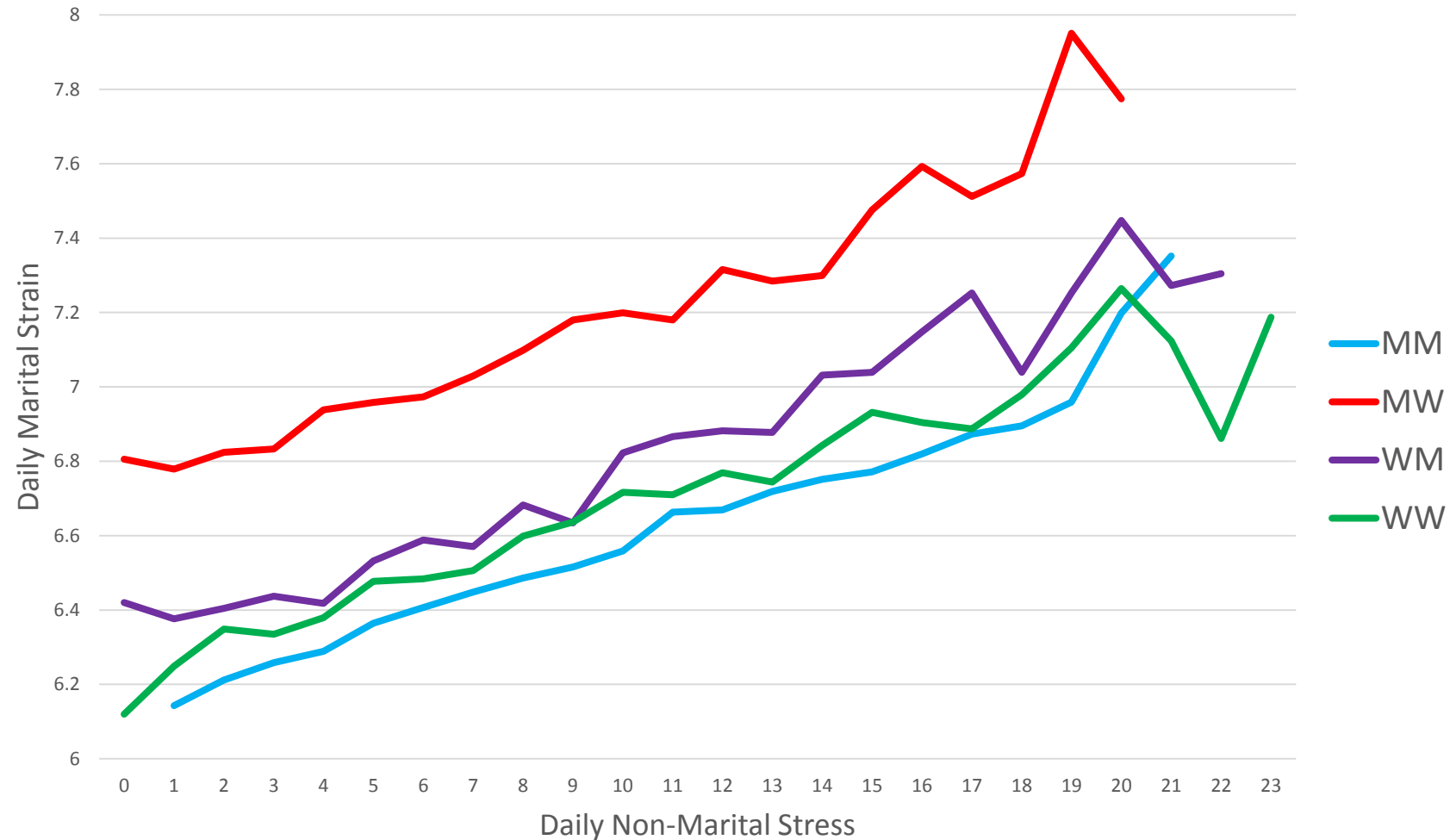
- Research on heterosexual marriages

 - Interactions differ within gay, lesbian, and heterosexual relationships
- Nuanced analyses
 - Men with Men, Men with Women, Women with Men, Women with Women



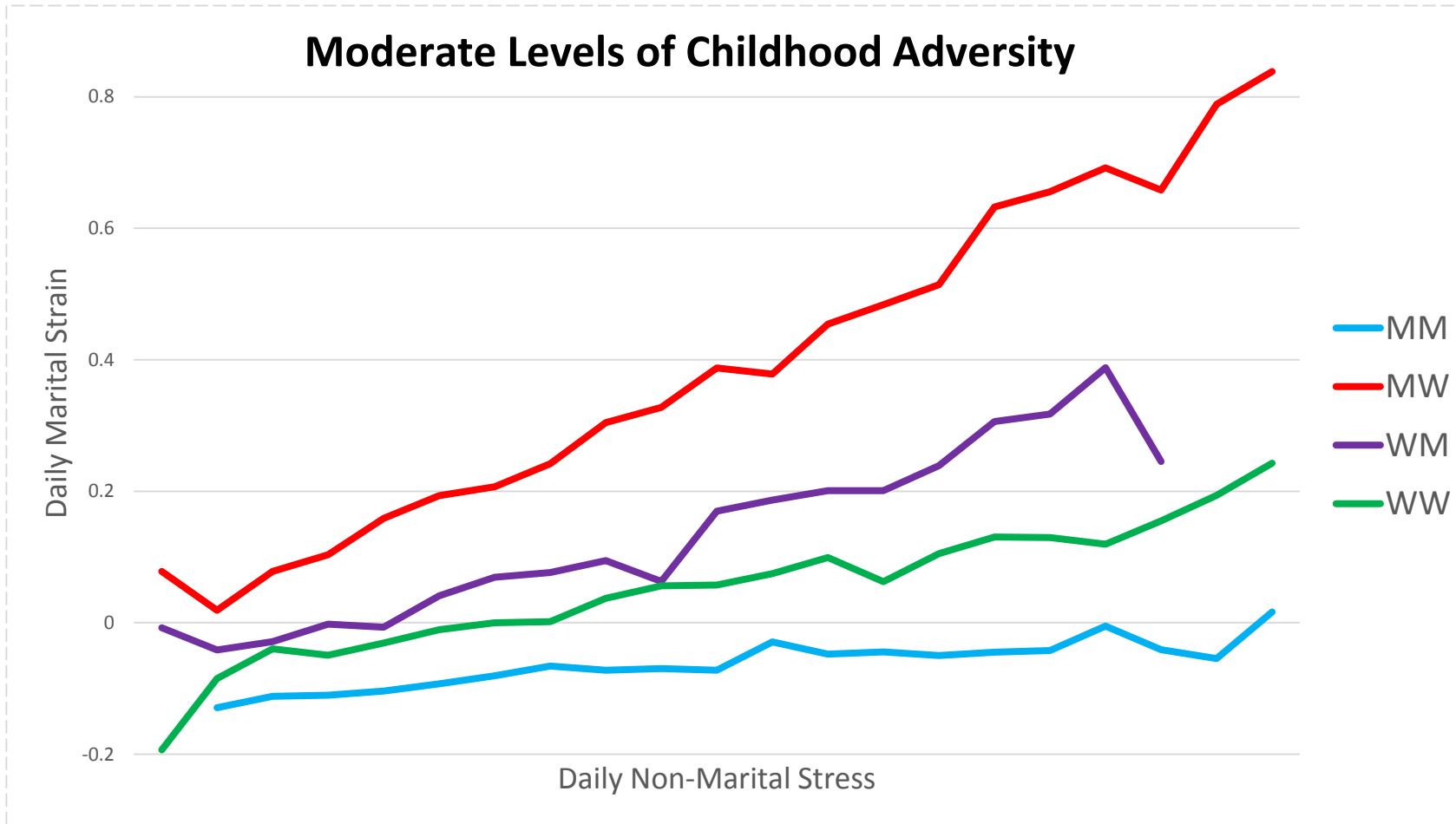
Standard Scores of Childhood Adversity, Daily Stress, and Marital Strain



Daily Non-Marital Stress is Associated with Marital Strain



Childhood Adversity Moderates the Impact of Daily Stress on Marital Strain
