### 1. Committee Task Force:

- From Hannah McFarren: Email was sent to announce committee members
- Want to send an email out for committees to meet and "change hands" by 21st of November
- Created forms for feedback to student affairs to get monthly feedback from committees, got feedback from UT Undergraduate on how they did this



- Still questions about how to work best with other student groups not overseen by Senate in order to best support them and work with UT at large (becoming a Student Registered Organization, etc.)
- Do we know how the Law School does this?
- Perhaps have a pamphlet at orientation to clearly explain what organizations exist/how to get involved

## 2. Bylaw Task Force

- Virginia and Megan: Did some research, Georgetown School of Medicine had great examples
- Re-emphasize that bylaws have to be proposed and voted on at SEPARATE meetings
- We want to ensure that the election is weighted by what order (ie if you are picked as first, you will get 6 points, if you are picked second you will get 5 points)
- We also want to ensure that it is communicated that the person with the MOST votes will be voted as PRESIDENT
- Want to propose bylaw on November 13th meeting
- Vote on bylaw November 27th
- Open election December 1st, morning December 4th results need to be
