- 1) Approve Minutes from 03/05/2018
 - a) Approved by unanimous consent
- 2) Vote on Senate attendance bylaw
 - a) Motion: Jonathan
 - b) Seconded: Taylor
 - c) Approved: Yes (Passes unanimously; assents: 13 dissents: 0)
- 3) Culture
 - a) First, Leonard cannot receive emails from Dell -- this is a known problem. Secondly, Leonard would like to address the fact that MS2's cannot participate in culture office hours.
 - b) Perhaps use the online wiki? Brooke to send email to her class promoting this.
 - c) Woody will follow up with Lucas from Design Institute.
- 4) OR Lounge: This has been resolved. Access has been regranted.
- 5) Open Time from Brooke
 - a) AOA how, when, choosing? More competitive specialities care about this group. Top 25% of the class academically is eligible - <u>this does not change the fact that we are pass, fail in the first</u> <u>year; they will not have access to any test scores from 1st year</u>. Top 16% can be admitted - they are selected by local chapter of AOA which cannot be established until we have provisional accreditation which will hopefully be in June - that is when we will apply. Created by a group of faculty because that's all that can at this point. They will decide about how to do the picking.



They will hold the election and announce who is in until we have full accreditation - January of 2020. <u>Too late for class of 2020 - BUT WAIT. Steve is conniving. Will be able to put "To be inducted into AOA..." In your letters, etc.</u>

b) GHHS - Primary care cares more about this #wordplay. All about how humanistic, compassionate, other-centered you are. Election by your peers. Ballots cannot be issued until shortly after clerkships or after everyone has finished 3rd year. Steve doesn't think it matters much for class of 2020. This will definitely be done in time! 16% can be elected into this. Steve will double check this number.

6) Steve's General Announcements

- a) Accounting: To the best of Steve's knowledge, every student who was owed money has the money in their bank account. The Accounting robots, I mean people, have realized this is an issue and are working on resolving this for the future.
- b) Weather: Quick summary includes 1st years follows big poppa UT due to weather related issues. If it's a clinical facility, then you don't go. If the facility is a hospital and doesn't close and is on restricted duty, then you don't go. There is an exception, if you are in an acting internship or if you're in a role with a high level of patient responsibility and you think you can get there safely you can call to request that you can come in.

- 7) Taylor: How are student groups getting money?
 - a) Every group was allocated up to \$200 for a "recruitment" meeting
 - b) The records are held with Tamara. This is a problem to get kicked to the budget and finance task force. They are going to compile a record and make it available to student affairs and senate.
 - c) That being said, the root of the problem is access to funds that will "okay" funds. Hence the representation on main campus.
 - d) Khaled to follow up and clarify about groups.
- 8) Brooke/Virginia
 - Photo opps will be equally distributed to intra-Dell Med marketing BUT we need an updated list
 - Jaime to send this to get up-to-date records
- 9) Taylor: Roles in Senate?
 - Do we want to create specific roles in order to relieve burden on presidents
 - According to the constitution, we are wide open about senate structure. This is another can of worms to be opened in bylaws.
 - Generally, we like structure. We need to think about long-term impact (ultimately, 2 people / society / class).
 - Taylor and Megan to work on bylaw to present to Senate

10) Toli: Sink in Tower Lounge

- No flow and it is making noises; it has idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis.
- This is more of a widespread issue; bathroom fixes needed and LGI upkeep

- Formalized process for maintenance requests; for HLB and HDB

- 12) Meeting invite best practices by Virginia and Woody
 - Current problem: Official student orgs using Facebook to advertise events which forces people to use Facebook who HATE IT WITH THE HEAT FROM A MILLION FIRES.
 - \circ $\;$ We want the least restrictive path as possible. Proposed solution:
 - Require that announcement of all events hosted by official student orgs be sent by UT Mail to the relevant listserv(s) AND posted on Dell Med Knowlt Calendar +/- Facebook (or other platform).
 - If further updates will be provided on a different platform, this needs to be indicated in initial email.
 - Disseminate UT Mail and Facebook event best practices.
 - Support student orgs in adhering to best practices.
