- 1) Approve Minutes from 04/16/2018:
  - a) Corrections: No
  - b) Approved: Yes
- 2) Student Affairs General Announcements:
  - a) Guidelines for applying for funding (approved by Sue Cox earlier this week)
    - i) We are given \$20,000 (total, not for each group) and must submit form in a written proposal
    - ii) Must give purpose for group (50 word max), faculty advisor, affiliation, when election dates are, total number of members (active and general), events you have held in the past, total cost, per capita cost, what was the purpose of the event, did you co-sponsor (pro tip: they like co-sponsored events) etc.
    - iii) Applications should be in before "organizational hiatus" before MS1s finish in June and will be looked at before return
    - iv) These applications will be once a year and will be reviewed by a committee: Gerry Kelly, UT representative, Jaime, 4 students from senate
      - (1) Don't worry if you start mid-year, the committee will create a reserve in case another group pops up in the middle of the year
      - (2) Money will also be set aside in the event that a really exciting opportunity/speaker/event pops up midyear
      - (3) What will they look for include bang for your buck, community impact, can you show a benefit to the broadest group of students?, a benefit to DMS, a benefit to UT, and a benefit to the community etc.
    - v) More information to come directly from student affairs
    - vi) What is included: \$\$ for <u>food is included</u>, <u>but it can only be 10% of your entire</u> <u>budget proposal</u>, \$\$ for supplies (e.g. suture clinics, health screenings, registration)
    - vii) What is not included: travel is not included; this will come from a separate pot of money
    - viii) If the organization (1) does not send the year's officers to student affairs, and (2) does not conduct events in a professional manner, will forfeit all money for the year and the following year.
    - ix) Money must go straight to vendors; reimbursement is not an option. Plan ahead and Student Affairs will order it on your behalf.
  - b) Organization of Orgs and Clubs



- i) Registered organizations have to be registered at UT
- ii) Listed organizations won't have to be registered at UT (they exist because senate exists) → this means they won't have to go through training on main campus
- iii) Governance: committees and government-related organizations; student representatives should be appointed by the Senate instead of by faculty
- iv) Student Affairs Partners: advisory and assist from student affairs
  - (1) Orientation committee: TBD whether there will be increased student involvement when 4th years
- 3) Senate Committee Elections: Dekoiya
  - a) A bylaw has been drafted to help align student interests with a better process to serve on committees. We will vote on this bylaw at the next meeting.
- 4) Open Time

    - i) Approved unanimously
