V. Communication

- A. Feedback from PCP about budgets, travel funds, etc. (Brooke)
 - 1. Primary Care Progress has not spent much money because most of the opportunity is in incentives to bring people in to meeting and Dell money can't be spent on food
 - 2. Also difficulty with double-approval process
 - 3. Surgery IG got line-items approved on their budget and then denied when they tried to actually do what was approved
 - 4. Travel also doesn't come from this budget which is the other largest expense for groups after food
 - 5. Budget TF to propose rules...
 - 6. Data from students is data that requires change
 - 7. A bigger issue of the financial policies
 - a) They changed mid-year and did not communicate
 - b) Can only unlock \$500 for travel is you can get a GME department to match it
 - c) GME departments don't actually have any money for student travel
 - 8. Policies are being made without student input that requires us to do the legwork to fix it
 - 9. Senate needs to do something about this -- lots of feedback from students
 - 10. Action items:
 - a) Make a qualtrics survey to gather data to scope this problem
 - b) Obtain org chart of who is making these financial decisions
 - c) No Money, Mo Problems: Sam, Woody, Oliver, and Marielle
 - 11. Motion by Helen: We create as task force called Financial Policy to get at this issue of finance problems

- A. MS2 Feedback about planning for MS3 (Dekoiya, Sam, Megan)
 - 1. Planning for 3rd year
 - a) People are having difficulty
 - b) "I can't network", "I can't meet up with people"
 - c) "If we want to be a school that does research, we need to let people network."
 - d) Can we look at schools that take a year of research seriously and how they handle this?
 - e) Ask Sterling if he feels the research track is an important part of Dell
 - 2. Feelings of engagement at Dell

- a) ³/₄ of MS2s felt disengaged from Dell
- b) Time in hospital
- c) Choosing between assignments, studying, and going to events
- d) Correct path for this is UMEC by preamble to Senate constitution(1) How might we get people on UMEC to speak for MS2s?
- e) Concerns about legitimacy of survey: In the past, legitimate problems have been shot down by admin due to "low n" on previous issues
- f) First thing you have to prove is that this is actually a problem
 - (1) Need a majority of the class participating

B. Disseminating Course Evals (Brooke)

- 1. Is there an impetus for change
 - a) When you look at the end of course evals for all of the core clerkships, the average rating is 4.9 except for Women's Health which is 4.8 (out of 5)
- 2. Charlotte (on Assessments and Evaluations)
 - a) They go through the evals by detail and look at the lowest ratings and work to make change
 - b) The data point rated above is almost an afterthought at these meetings
 - c) Change is happening based on the other data points
- 3. Final reports of eval are not being disseminated
 - a) They should be, but are not currently
- 4. Maybe Senate should host a training for MS1s to impress the importance of the feedback when you want to do anything else at the end of the clerkship?
 - a) Transparency on how the data is handled and the rules they have to follow
