- A. Quorum discussion- Sam
  - With MS2 and MS4 schedules, it is really difficult to meet quorum
  - Root Cause Analysis:
    - a) Is the problem that we have a disproportionate number of MS4s on Senate right now?
    - b) Is this a problem of timing?
  - Solutions:
    - a) Is there a way to suspend quorum for the year as this seems to be an isolated problem?

- b) Bylaw about the appropriate number to miss and enforce this?
  - (1) Bylaw to call-in and participate remotely
  - (2) Bylaw about how many misses
- c) Change quorum? 50% + 1?
