I. Culture of Wellness

II. Student Representation

- A. Constitution update and vote- Brooke (10 minutes)
 - Discussed and sent-out to the student body
 - Tonight, we are voting to amend the Constitution that affects article II and article V
 - a) 3 Dellegates / year
 - b) Changed dellegate timeline to 2 year terms
 - c) One meeting / month from one meeting / semester
 - Required to get a 10% of the student body to sign a petition to be considered for voting and we have surpassed
 - "I move to amend the student body constitution in accordance with the changes that were proposed by the constitution task force."
 - a) Taylor moves to suspend the Roberts' rules and to be approved by unanimous consent
 - b) Oliver seconds to suspend the Roberts' rules and to be approved by unan
 - c) Passed by unanimous consent.

- B. Non-Senate Participation Bylaw voting Sam (5 minutes)
 - Megan: I pass to pass the "Non-Senate Attendance and Participation bylaw"
 - Brooke: Seconded
 - Passed by unanimous consent
 - Sam: to update "rules" and come back to Senate with updated living document
- C. Student Feedback
 - Josh Morris (10 minutes)
 - a) Topic 1:
 - (1) Presentation to Senate about marketing and communicating what we do as a Senate
 - (2) Idea: we have struggled with out platforms, but what if we have a Canvas page? The only problem with this is the theoretical benefit of students creating their own Canvas page
 - b) Topic 2:
 - (1) Lack of professional development as far as the untimeliness and too much of 'rainbows and unicorns'.
 - (2) Proposal 1:
 - (a) Peer development system: informal network of peers to coach and guide
 - (b) Established through shared principles of feedback
 - (c) Missing a component of professional development
 - (3) Proposal 2:
 - (a) In-house incubator group: roundtable feedback that is professional and helps students work through ideas → I have this idea that I would like to pursue and you need people to give feedback and help grow
 - (b) For all classes, by all classes
 - c) Solutions:
 - (1) Structured environment for talking through ideas (usually, entrepreneurial)
 - (2) We're working on longitudinal, vertical relationships and we need to work on peer-to-peer lateral relationships → Is it possible that if we create this vertical change, the lateral change / culture change will happen down the road
 - (3) Inject into the training for peer coaches and peer coach partners the idea for lateral coaching

III. Academic/Professional/Personal Development

- A. Peer Development Program Update Brooke + Charlotte (10 min)
 - Met with Patty Prado 11/19 about coaching for growth mindset
 - Talked through logistics: how often to meet and how many students: mentor and how to ensure quality on both ends
 - Update: Patty Prado has agreed to help us train peer coaches, do a training session for MS1s/MS2s coaching partners and to do feedback after the sessions to make sure (1) it happened, (2) improve, (3) coaches to ask for help
 - Granular part of this: MS3 and MS4 opt-in
 - a) We will clarify vocab and market /match through DOCS
 (1) 2 MS3s and 2 MS4s (to 2-3 MS1s/MS2s)
 - Beta test goal: get through training in early january to make sure first contact is after clerkship feedback for MS2s and MS3s after feedback mechanism
 - To give DOCS the first way to have a mentor with a secondary as a larger pool of mentors
 - To give set aside time for MS2 intersessions or MS1 after lecture
