- A. Swag Discussion Lana (10 minutes)
 - Proposed idea:
 - a) Problem: Current situation with Dell Med Merch is not great and creating school spirit is important
 - Vision: Create an online student-only store through a joint senate-non-senate task-force and using SOCC as budget source
 - (1) Summer budget from SOCC: class-specific T-shirts
 - (2) Long-term goal is a self-sufficient store that students can interface with
 - (3) For now: Senate task force for now → creating a committee under Senate of College Councils that includes non-Senate members

- C. Senate Attendance and Virtual Attendance Bylaw Megan (10 minutes)
 - Attendance Issues:

- D. Student Feedback: (5 minutes)

"The third year involves juggling many priorities and responsibilities. I'm currently struggling with how to hold classmates accountable in groups/projects that require a regular commitment. It might be difficult to prescribe teamwork among 3rd year students, but maybe a bit more advance discussion around time requirements for 3rd year would be helpful (i.e. How does everything fit in?)."

Since this feedback was anonymous here are the thoughts from Senate:

- We feel your pain!
- Gather data on the details of these teams (is this happening to just your team or is this more systemic?)
- Sometimes you have to change your expectations to make this work and facilitates conversation (Brooke mentioned she used to have timelines that weren't shared by her teammates so she had to learn to adapt, perhaps some members think contributing 1 hour per week is enough and you think it should take 5 hours per week, did you talk about it beforehand? Were the expectations shared or discussed? Do you need to discuss them as a team and re-group?)
- Resources that could help you with these conversations: The Rocket Model (via Dr. Eddie Erlandson)
- Are there other faculty members who could help you have these conversations that you could reach out to?

- A. Peer Development Program Update Brooke + Charlotte + Megan (10 min)
 - Guidelines being reviewed by the senate
 - Will reach out to the MS3s and MS4s to gather interested groups for mentorship
 - a) MS1 and MS2 to follow
 - Goal: have peer coaching beta test up and running by January 2020
 - Horizontal mentorship
 - a) DOCS feedback improvements --> coaching in the DOCS course
