 - 1. Patterns are not holding up this year. Some reasons for this include programs contacting students to fill their interview slots ahead of the recommended dates. This was unexpected.
 - 2. It appears that students from Texas medical schools are being offered plenty of interviews in Texas but are not as successful out of state
 - 3. Steve recommends MS4s be more aggressive than is typical with those love letters. He encourages you to ask for faculty to reach out on your behalf.
