III. Student Affairs Updates (30 min)

- B. Assessing need for academic support during MS2 year (Evelyn)
 - UMEC HCD committee has been discussing this need in the context of rising percentage of shelf exam failures. Current proposals include collecting information from students about what students need support in
 - a) Senate Response: it's several things going on simultaneously...
 - (1) Notes are billable and help students feel useful to the team but are they cutting into study time?
 - (2) Could student schedules be optimized for more studying (i.e. cutting saturday rounds and looking for other opportunities to increase study budget):
 - (3) Cultural things: feeling like you can't study during wards "down time" for fear of appearing disinterested
 - b) Action Item: Follow up on clerkship independent study half-day proposal that Catherine presented to UMEC earlier this year
 - 2. How can we promote a culture of understanding, forgiveness, and flexibility?
 - a) We need admin help here. We don't see this as something that can be student-run
 - Action Item: meet with admin to share student perspectives on wellness during clerkships, school culture, and community building in an accelerated curriculum

VII. Culture of Wellness (10 min)

- A. Senate Happy Hour (Sam)
 - 1. Recognizing the desire to connect and zoom fatigue, can we bring in-person happy hour events back?
 - a) Per social distancing policy cannot hold interest group or senate functions in person
 - b) Virtual Dell Med Coffee Break?
 - (1) Not enough interest. Barriers are zoom fatigue, scheduling conflicts from clinical duties and class times

VIII. Student Body Feedback (10 min)

A. Summarized for brevity, see *Academic/Professional/Personal Development* for related discussion

- 1. Lack of access to academic support as MS2, particularly around shelf exams
- 2. Costs of outside academic resources recommended for MS2 year
- 3. School culture around failures: need to change language from "Is your failure a pattern?" to "What support do you need?" and promote a culture of understanding, forgiveness, and flexibility
- 4. Some clerkship projects and assignments do not effectively contribute to learning
