III. Student Affairs Updates/ Q&A (30 min)

- A. Microsoft Teams transition is required for all DMS Registered Specialty Interest Groups and Orgs. There are no exceptions.
 - (1) Event planning must be performed on Teams
 - (2) Orgs must be transitioned to request funding
 - (3) Private channels are now allowed for org leadership in order to better collaborate within 1 platform. Be advised that Teams is linked to the school eid

- B. **Dr. Nelson:** we have met with MS1s who presented feedback from their class in the form of a survey as well as proposed suggestions. Currently working through the proposed solutions to decide next steps.
- C. **Question from MS2 senator:** students in the MS3 MPAff degree program have questions about a math class we are expected to take over the summer
 - 1. We suggest these students email Stacy Abrams
- D. **Question from MS4 senator:** when will the schedule for our residency preparation milestone course be sent out?
 - 1. Dr. Neson I will check in with Gabie Portillo to get the dates/time frame out to your class
- E. Question from MS3 Senator: Can we create a timeline and FAQ document for the VSLO requirements so in future years students are prepared before applications open?
 - An outline of the VSLO process already exists. Will revisit what is included in this document and the timing in which it is introduced/re-emphasized to MS3s.

IV. Student Representation

- A. Academic Governance elections proposals
 - 1. Constitution Amendment (Article III, Committees) must be approved first
 - a) We have enough signatures on the petition (thanks to all who signed!)
 - b) The MSS may ratify the amendment by a two-thirds vote of the entire MSS (15 for us). If they don't ratify it, MSS must refer the proposed amendment for Student Body vote.
 - c) Approved tonight by $> \frac{2}{3}$ of the medical student senate
 - (1) These updates will be made to all internal and public facing constitutional documents
 - 2. Vote on Academic Governance Protocol bylaw

 - b) Approved tonight by > majority of the medical student senate
 - 3. Discussion on Senate Elections bylaw (new proposal)
 - a) Need to update language referencing the Class of 2020
 - b) Also need to clarify senate term start dates
 - Outline the process by which FERPA confidentiality is protected given that student affairs requires approval of the nominated senators from an academic standpoint
 - (1) Given the FERPA privacy requirements, who should be responsible for running the elections? Senate or student affairs?
 - (a) If senate creates the ballot we will have access to the results...introducing the privacy issue.

- (b) We would like senate to have a say in the construction of the ballot given our experience running these elections. We can send a copy of the qualtrix survey we currently use to the student affairs office
- (c) Most appropriate to have this discussion with someone from student affairs present. Will table any decisions until all stakeholders are present.
- d) Timeline of senate elections
- e) What is the timeline for the next senate elections?
 - (1) Currently getting UMEC elections done, then will announce senate timeline
 - (2) We will consider this in determining the senat
 - (3) Discussion:
 - (a) Now that the UMEC elections will be conducted via student-wide vote (rather than by senate vote) can we run both elections cycles simultaneously?
 - (b) elect MS2s for their MS3 term over the winter break of their clerkship year for the term that starts in September of their MS3 year
 - (a) 9 months in advance allows nominees to think about whether they want to accept the position + more time to transition the new presidents. But is it too early?
 - (ii) Could we conduct MS2 elections during an spring semester intersession?
 - (a) The April MS2 intercession involves the leadership shelf exam so may not be the best option
 - (iii) How long should the election ballot remain open? Some ideas:
 - (a) give ppl longer window to increase participation? 1 week vs just the weekend
 - (b) Open and close it during an intercession to introduce urgency/convenience while the "audience is captive"
- 4. **Action item:** Follow UMEC election cycle the Constituition/Bylaws and Elections task forces will meet to incorporate changes to senate election bylaw with input of Student Affairs regarding privacy concerns

- 1. Will senate continue to meet over summer?
 - a) Historically we haven't TBD!
 - (1) Rising MS3 senators will be in dedicated, rising MS2s and MS4s will be transitioning to Als/clerkships
- 2. What questions does the senate have for our graduating MS4 senators?
