- Students may submit this GEC Travel Grant Application for attending conferences between the September 1st, 2018 to August 31st, 2019
 - o September 1st, 2018 March 29th, 2019: Please indicate the **unreimbursed cost**.
 - o March 30st, 2019 August 31st, 2019: Please indicate the **expected unreimbursed cost**.
- Students who receive the awards must be currently enrolled as a graduate student in the Cockrell School of Engineering at The University of Texas at Austin, as well as through Summer 2019.
- Evidence of conference attendance (i.e. a payment receipt of conference fee or letter from conference confirming your attendance) must be submitted with this form for consideration.

Upon Selection for the Award

- Awards are for **reimbursement only** and will only be processed upon completion of conference attendance. Advances will not be considered.
- Copies of receipts for major expenses (i.e. airfare, rental car, etc.) will be required for awarding money.
- A letter or e-mail confirmation of conference attendance from the awardee's advisor is requested.
- Recipients who are Nonresidents for tax purposes are subjected to a withholding tax.
- Travel grants are awarded as a reimbursement for personal expenditures not covered by any other external source (grants, scholarship, fellowship, etc.). Up to \$500, per recipient pre-tax, will be awarded based on recipient's merits and need.
