TIESplus

- Fee-based (sponsorship and financial aid available)
- Weekly or biweekly meetings
- Unlimited drop-ins
- Transitional support (incoming students and post-graduation)
- Required professional and social development
- Required academic development
- Canvas, e-newsletter, Slack
- Only undergraduate students eligible
- Must enroll prior to start of semester

Drop-In

- Free
- Initial consult appointment
- Three drop-in meetings per semester
- Undergraduate and graduate students eligible
- Can request drop-in meetings at any point in the semester
- Option to apply for TIESplus after one semester of drop-in meetings
