

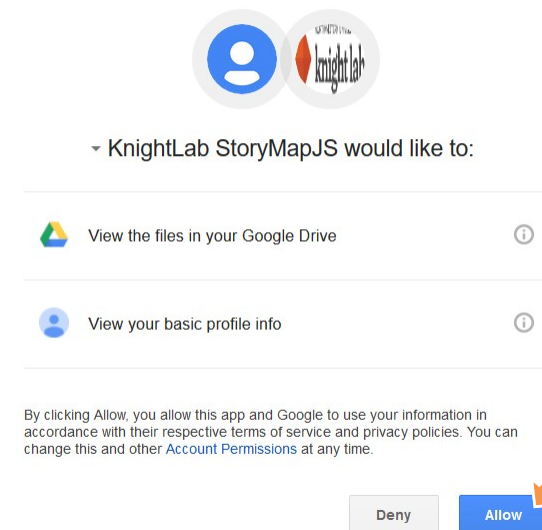
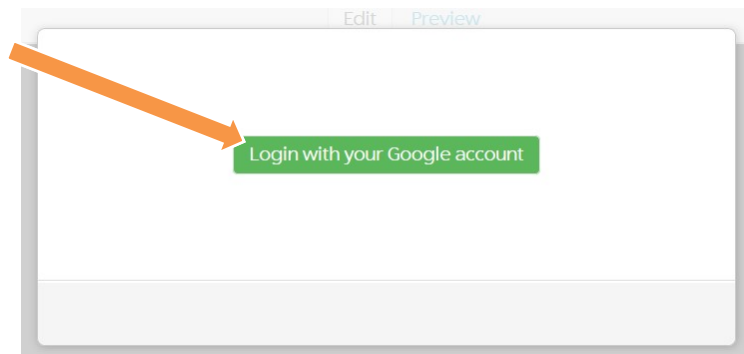
Creating a Gigapixel StoryMapJS using Selections from “Mapping Mexican History”

(Gmail account required.)

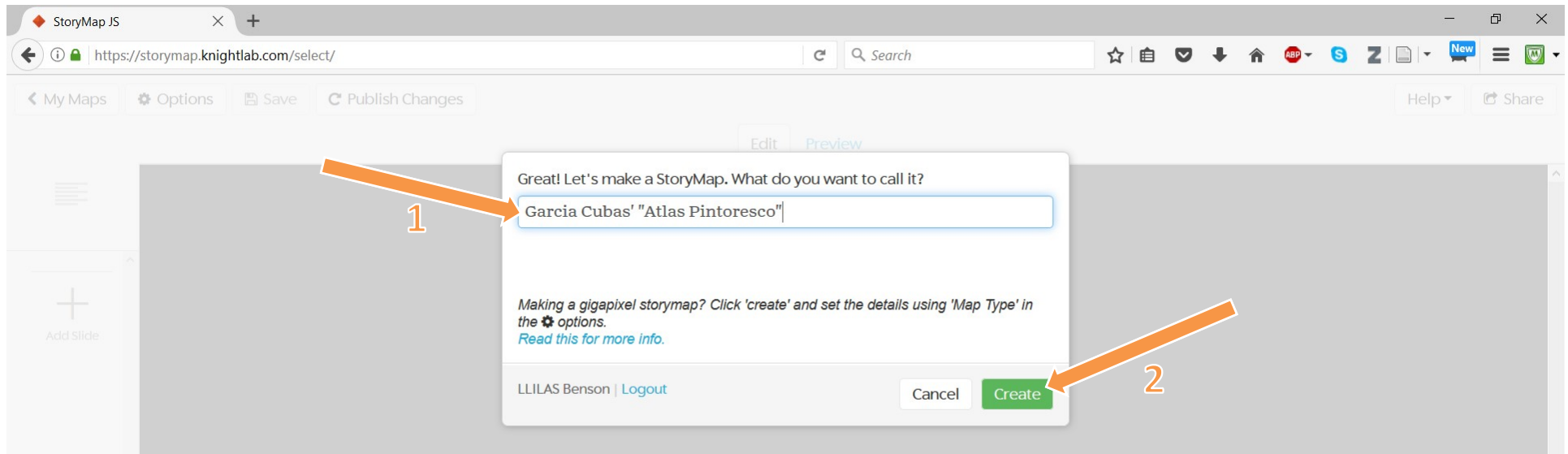
- Navigate to <https://storymap.knightlab.com>.
- Click on **Make a storymap now**.



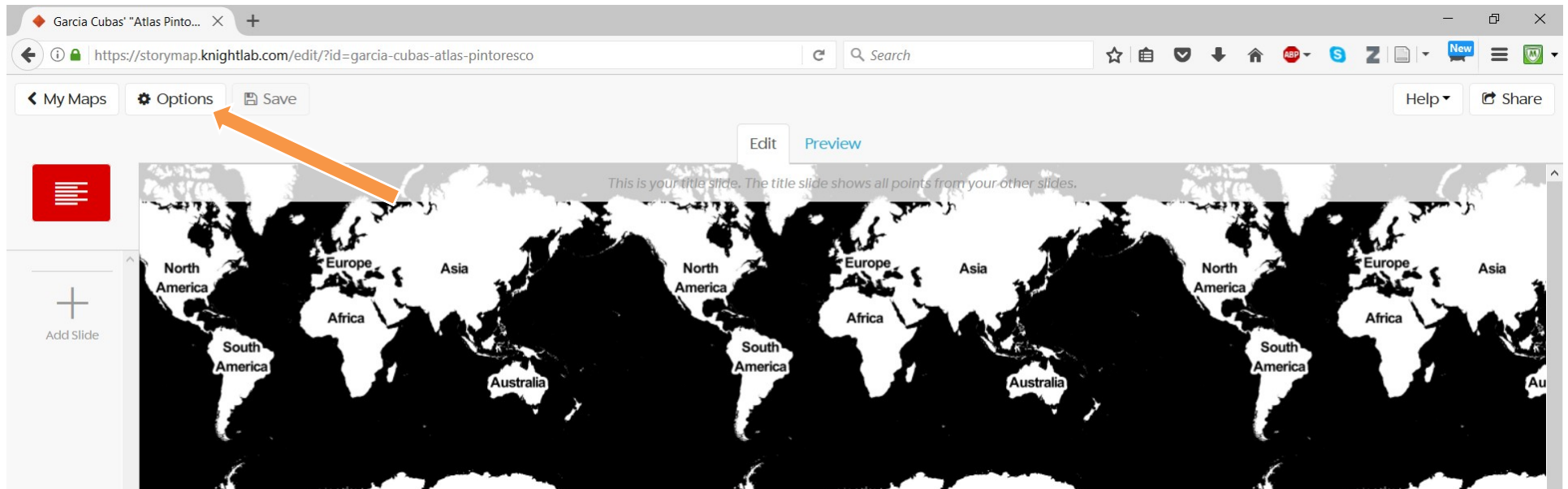
- This will navigate you to a page where you will be required to **Login with your Google account** and **Allow** Knight Lab to have limited account access.



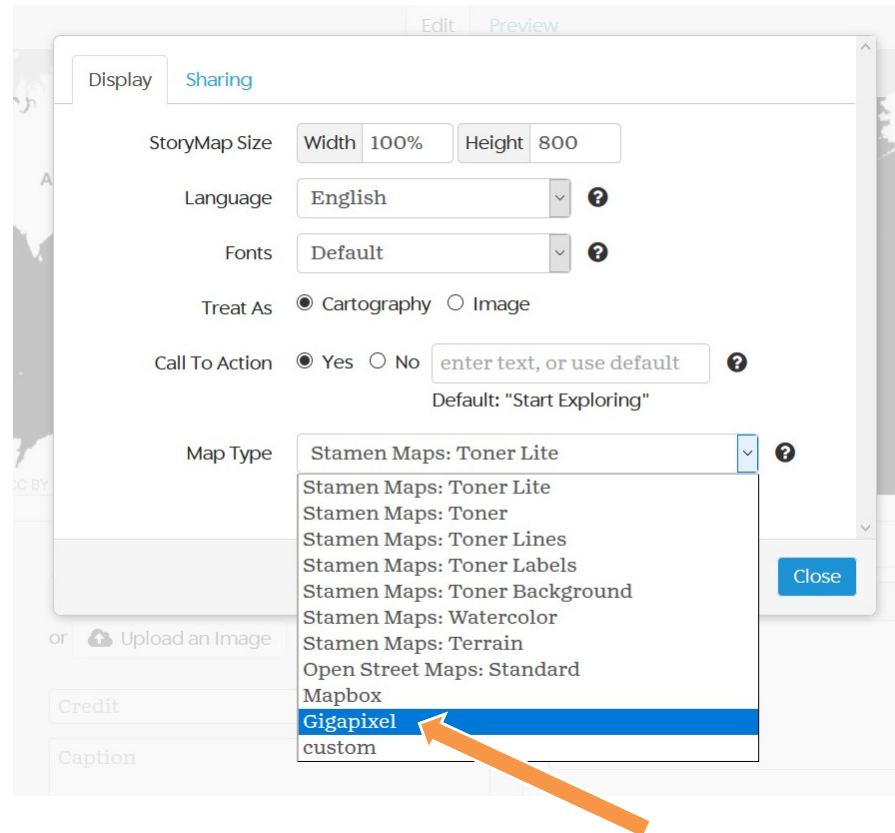
- Enter a title for your StoryMap and click on **Create**.



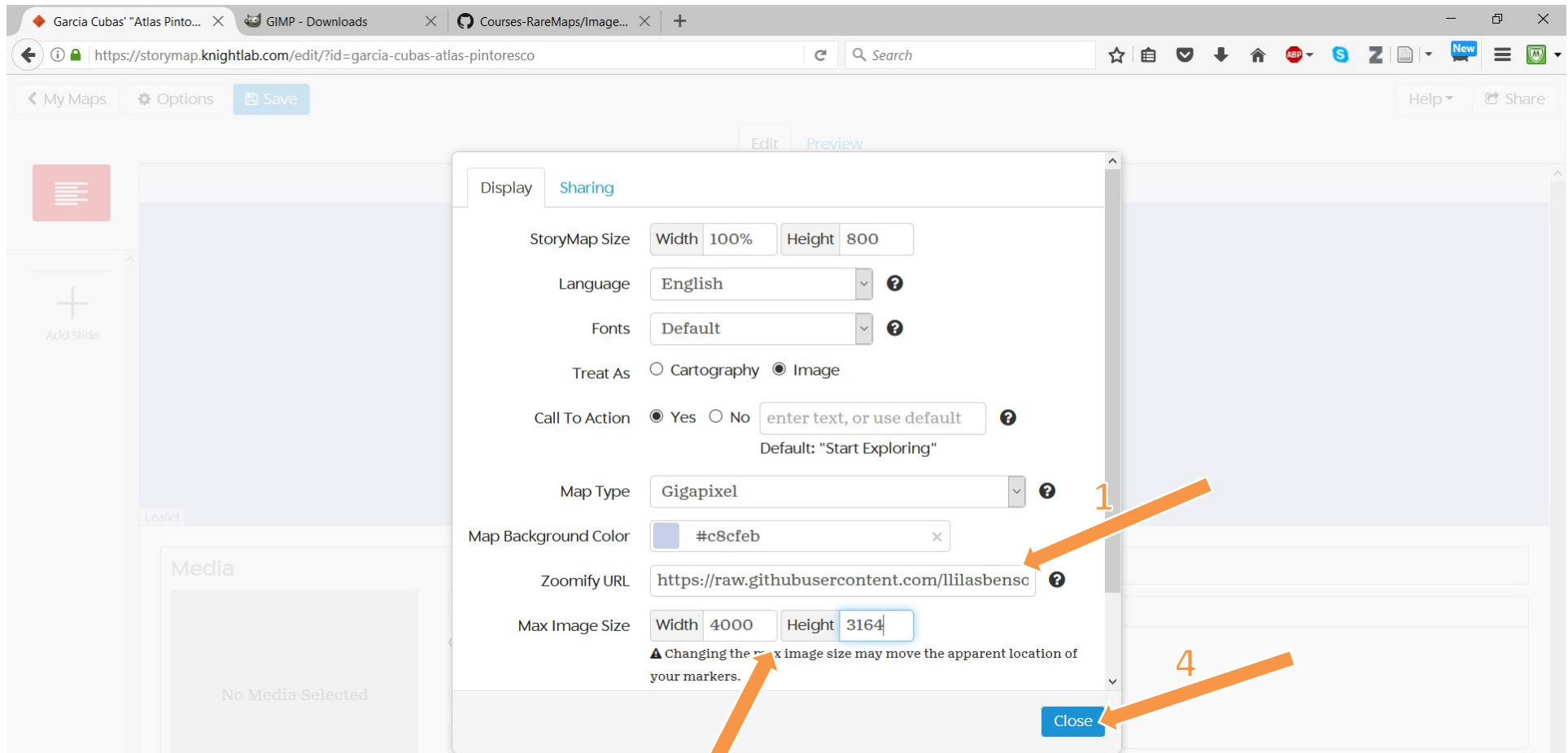
- Click on **Options**.



- Under the **Map Type** drop-down menu, select **Gigapixel**.



- Copy and paste the “raw.github...” or “lib.utexas.edu” addresses in the following page into the **Zoomify URL** entry field.
- Enter the image dimensions below the link in the following page into StoryMapJS’s **Width** and **Height** entry fields. Click on when done **Close**.
