

Bump on the Road

- The Hansen memo, January 30, 2003
 - Stricter interpretation of FERPA
 - For the Texas Workforce Commission to comply with the requirements of SB281
 - Share UI Wage Records with Higher Education
 - Share UI Wage Records with Public Education
 - Allowed our education partners to link education records to UI and produced the reports required under SB281

Recent Developments

- Data Sharing Agreements with
 - Texas State Technical College System
 - University of Texas System
 - Share student level data for document post-exit labor market outcomes
 - Capture occupational title through supplemental employer follow-up survey
 - Produce detailed analyses tables using explanatory variables not available from the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board reports.
