The Special Programs Coordinator is responsible for communicating, information, investigating and requesting volunteers for and about certain UT programs and events in which RFSA participates. These opportunities are both in person and online. The Special Programs Coordinator works closely with RFSA Leadership and the Texas Exes liaison.

Events and Contributions

- Orange Santa: Donations to help make the holidays brighter for children of UT students, staff and faculty online donations and in-person cash donations, usually at the RFSA Holiday Party (December)
- 40 Hours for 40 Acres: Online giving campaign for UT programs, colleges, departments across UT. RFSA participates by asking for donations to the RFSA Scholarship Fund (April)
- UT Remembers program: memorial program which honors and remembers students, faculty, staff and retirees who have died in the previous year. RFSA members (usually after the Spring luncheon) make bookmark tassels and orange memorial loops as mementos for program guests (Last Friday of the spring semester/late April or early May)
- UT Outpost: free food pantry on campus for students experiencing food insecurity. RFSA members bring non-perishable food to the Spring luncheon (April)
