Psychiatric nursing at Menninger has a long, rich history of evidence-based practice and collaboration with all members of the inpatient treatment team. Interdisciplinary perspectives from nursing staff, rehabilitation therapists, chemical dependency counselors, social workers, psychologists and psychiatrists offer insight into assessment and treatment of adolescent and adult patients. Nurse residents, like other trainees in mental health disciplines at The Menninger Clinic, learn to work on a treatment team, develop a treatment alliance with patients and provide a safe, supportive, therapeutic environment. Patients participate as active
