The Program

Eligibility & Requirements

- Ideal candidates will have a minimum Nursing GPA of 3.0.
- Completion of nursing degree (ADN or BSN) from an accredited program.
- Current, unencumbered Texas RN license.
- BLS Certification.

Cohort Information

We offer opportunities throughout the year. Start date options vary based on area hired and successful NCLEX completion. You can still apply before you receive your NCLEX results, but you will need to have successfully completed NCLEX before the first day the program begins.

The Program is Designed to Support:

- Centralized recruitment, including the application, interview, and hiring process.
- Onboarding and Orientation, including central and specialty practice track specific orientation, as well as targeted population-specific education and professional development opportunities designed to meet the needs of the transitioning nurse by experienced Clinical Coach preceptors and MHHS content experts.
- Length of orientation is dependent upon the nursing specialty and the individual nurse's progression.

Timelines for each specialty area are used as a guide and can be tailored to meet the need of the nurse resident:

Acute Care Areas	12 - 14 weeks
Critical Care/Labor and Delivery	22 - 24 weeks
Perioperative Services	43 - 45 weeks

- Mentorship, continued career guidance and support for ongoing professional development continues beyond the first year and throughout the career of the MHHS nursing professional.
