## General Meetings

Every Other Wednesday, 6-7 pm

- Representatives can share information on the company followed by a Q&A
- Company representatives discuss your company, including daily life, interesting projects, potential opportunities, etc.

Flexible Date & Time

- Held during the daytime, students & representatives can have lunch together

Flexible Date & Time

- Similar to Lunch & Learns
- Students separated into groups with a student to representative ratio of 5:1
- Intimate setting for students to discuss questions and learn more about company from representatives

## Site Visits

Flexible Date & Time

- Students will travel to company's office
- Networking with corporate representatives and learn more about the company's operations
- Great way to gain exposure to the company

## Custom Event

Flexible Date & Time

- Up to corporate representatives to decide on topic & style of event
- Low-stress environment to connect with corporate representatives
- Examples: Yoga Retreat, Tailgate, etc.
