

The National Museum of the Pacific War (NMPW), founded in 1967, is the only institution in the continental United States dedicated exclusively to a mission "to engage and inspire present and future generations with the story of World War II in the Asiatic-Pacific Theater and interpret the continued global relevance of its lessons." Spanning six acres in downtown Fredericksburg, Texas, the Museum features three galleries with more than 55,000 square feet of exhibit space.

The NMPW offers hands-on experience working at a museum in a specialized field. As an ambassador, you will get hands-on experience, develop projects, and attend workshops that offer career insights and behind-the-scenes opportunities.

- 10 weeks long
- 20 hours a week (unpaid)
- Weekly schedules arranged by supervisors
- Some nights and weekends (dependent on department)

 - resume and portfolio building assistance
- Hands-on experience
- Museum career insights

Required Documents:

- Cover Letter
- Resume
- At least one letter of recommendation or two references from a current or former teacher or employer

The NMPW does not grant academic credit. However, we will work with ambassadors to provide letters of support that verify the student's participation in the program.
