Explore the Blox on the “ADD BLOX” and decide what tools you may want

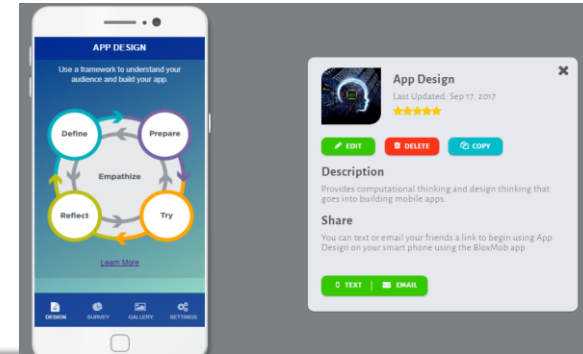
- Calendars for events and guests

- Who will test my app and give me feedback?

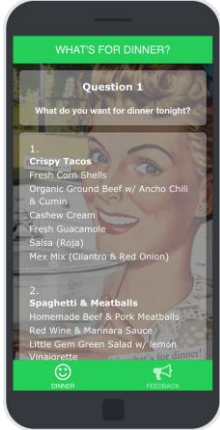
Start small, be specific to an audience you know, iterate, and refine.

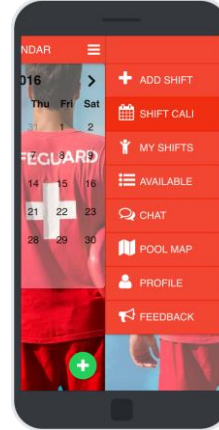
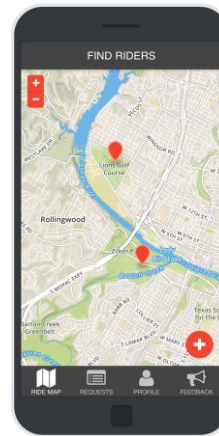


Event Apps

- Information and celebration of activities
- Coordinate volunteers
- Share photos



Transportation Apps

- Bike routes and information
- Car pool notifications
- Surveys and comments
- Updates on closures or changes

Place Apps

- Recommendations on things to do at various locations
- Neighborhood park app to share history, events, and more
- Detail maps of location and points of interest
